Club Rules/Policies

Just a gentle reminder for January that it is important that all gymnasts (and their parents!) to stick to our club rules to help us maintain a high standard in our classes and to keep everyone safe.

Jewellery of any kind may not be worn in classes by gymnasts or coaches. If your child has just had their ears pierced then you must cover their earrings before they come to class. Hair must be tied back too.
