



BRITISH GYMNASTICS MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

Dear Parents,

Your child's British Gymnastics membership and insurance is now due for renewal.

The membership is not new, it is payable annually in September to cover a period of 1st of October to 3rd September. If gymnasts are members of other British gymnastics registered clubs (including trampolining or cheerleading clubs) you do not have to pay membership twice, either pay through us or the other club and show your membership card to all coaches so they can note your membership number.

It is a condition of registration that a British Gymnastics registered club must register all its participants otherwise it will invalidate the insurance cover of the club.

HOW MUCH ARE MEMBERSHIP FEES?

£20 for recreational gymnastics and £45 squad gymnasts, this is broken down in the following way:

The British Gymnastics bronze associate membership fee (for recreational gymnasts) is £15.00 for the year 2010 – 2011. For competitive gymnasts the silver associate membership fee is £40.

The remaining £5 is the club membership fee and this goes towards the administration costs of registering every member individually with British gymnastics and the club registration fee.

This is equivalent to just under £2 a month; unfortunately we cannot add it on to the course fee because it must be paid in full at the start of the insurance year not in installments throughout the year.

Please could you fill in the registration form attached and make sure all payments are handed in to a coach by the 1st of October. Payments must be in an envelope with the child's name, class attending and 'BG Insurance' written clearly on the front. Cheques payable to:
